## Sessional Teaching Positions DEPARTMENT OF PHYSICS & ASTRONOMY

Position 1 will teach 12 credit hours: **74:151** *General Physics I* and **74:152** *General Physics II* plus associated first year laboratories and **74:382** *Intermediate Mechanics*. Position 2 will teach 6 credit hours: **74:383** *Electromagnetic Fields and Waves* and **74:473** *Atomic and Nuclear Physics*.

**Qualifications:** A PhD is preferred; however, candidates with a Master's degree and successful record of teaching experience may be considered.

Start dates: Position 1: August 31, 2019; Position 2: December 28, 2019

Salary: \$6205 per 3 credit hours
